- · Scholars mention that this is a name of the Prophet SAW.
 - Allah never calls upon the Prophet SAW by his name directly in the Quran, unlike He did for other prophets.
 - It is out of the respect and love of Allah for the Prophet SAW that He calls him by other names.
- This grabs the attention of the Prophet SAW because something important will be mentioned soon after.

We did not reveal the Quran to you to make you suffer.

- The Prophet SAW would engage with the Quran to such an extent that his body would become weak.
- · Allah mentioned in Surah Al-Qiyamah:

لَا تُحَرِّكُ بِهِ لِسَانَكَ لِتَعْجَلَ بِهِ(٧٥:١٦) إِنَّ عَلَيْنَا جَمْعَهُ وَقُرْآنَهُ (٧٥:١٧)


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
